

## HS3.6 – Stables Access Policy

The New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Addington), t/a Addington Raceway and Event Centre, is committed to providing a safe facility for guests by ensuring that Health and Safety legislation is complied with at all times. Our staff work hard to reduce the risk of accident or injury but are unable to eliminate all the risks involved when participating in racing activities.

### Stable Access is Restricted to Those Holding Licenses or Stable Access Passes

The Stables and the adjoining Float Carpark are considered a workplace and contain equipment which could cause serious injury if not handled correctly. In addition, horses residing in these areas could cause serious injury to people that do not have experience around racehorses or general horse awareness. As a result, access to The Stables at Addington Raceway is restricted.

### Access to The Stables at Addington will only be provided to:

- Licensed participants (trainers, drivers, stablehands) and their assistants
- Owners that hold a valid Owners' Pass
- Owners that hold a valid Stables Access Pass that has been obtained from the race day reception desk
- Children aged 6 - 14 years old that have passed the Stabling Area Awareness Course (SAAC), and are under the supervision of an authorised adult
- Addington Raceway officials, staff and approved contractors

### NO PERMISSION to access The Stables will be granted to:

- Members of the general public and non-licensed participants (except for Owners with a valid Stables Access Pass)
- Pushchairs / strollers, people on crutches, wheelchairs without an attendant, and others with restricted mobility

### Owners

- Owners with a horse racing at the meeting can gain access to The Stables with their Owners' Pass. This pass must be presented clearly at all times
- If an Owner does **NOT** have a horse racing at the meeting, they are **NOT** entitled to be in The Stables
- Children of Owners will be prohibited unless they hold a SAAC Pass (see above)

### License and SAAC Holders


- License holders must present their current License in order to gain access to The Stables throughout the meeting
- SAAC holders must present their current Pass in order to gain access to The Stables throughout the meeting. SAAC holders must be under the supervision of an authorised adult

Any serious accident, incident or near miss to people, equipment or property in The Stables is to be reported as soon as possible to the Racing Secretary 03 338 9094 ext 836.


The NZMTC is not responsible, and accepts no liability for any loss, theft or damage to possessions resulting from accessing The Stables.

Security personnel will be situated at the entrance to The Stables enforcing this Policy and your co-operation is greatly appreciated. Unlawful attempts to access The Stables may result in your removal from Addington Raceway.
